Notification regarding Intermediate Even Semester Examinations, 2020 for eligible students

This is for information of all concerned that **Intermediate Even Semester Examinations, 2020 for eligible Students** of UG and PG academic programmes (for both CBCS and non CBCS semester system) of all departments under the Faculties of Arts, Fine Arts and Visual Arts of the University will be conducted as per resolutions adopted by the Executive Council in its emergency meetings held on 15.12.2020 and Examination Task Force in its meetings held on 23.12.2020, on the basis of the UGC Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar in view of COVID-19 Pandemic [vide D.O. NO. F1-1/2020 (Secy), dated 29th April, 2020 and vide D.O. NO. F1-1/2020 (Secy), dated 6th July, 2020], the verdict of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated August 28, 2020 issued in this matter. University shall strictly abide by the Guidelines issued by the University Grants Commission (UGC) regarding modalities of examinations and spirit in the best interest of students maintaining the sanctity of examination.

Detailed modalities of Intermediate Even Semester Examinations, 2020 for the eligible Students of UG and PG academic programmes of all departments under the Faculties of Arts, Fine Arts and Visual Arts of the University are mentioned below:

- 1. Intermediate Even Semester Examinations, 2020 [i.e. for UG (Arts and Fine Arts) - 2nd and 4th Semester; for UG (Visual Arts) - 2nd, 4th and 6th Semester; for PG (Arts, Fine Arts and Visual Arts) - 2nd Semester] of UG and PG academic programmes (for both CBCS and non CBCS semester system), B.Ed., B.Ed. (spl. Edu.) – 2nd Semester of all departments under the Faculties of Arts, Fine Arts and Visual Arts of the University will be conducted by composite of 50% marks for each course on the basis of the Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) and the remaining 50% marks for each course can be awarded on the basis of performance in previous semester SGPA only (if available).**

In the situations where previous semester SGPA are not available, 100% evaluation for each course may be done on the basis of Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA).

However, this above-mentioned provision shall be applicable only for the current academic session 2019-20 as a one-time measure as per UGC guidelines.


Candidates having any supplementary course/s [i.e. for UG (Arts and Fine Arts) - 2nd and 4th Semester; for UG (Visual Arts) - 2nd, 4th and 6th Semester; for PG (Arts, Fine Arts and Visual Arts) - 2nd Semester], don't have to sit for Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) for that supplementary course. CIA marks would be carried forward from earlier examination of that course, i.e. those candidates who already have 20% CIA marks but failed in that course, their 20% CIA marks of that course will be converted into 50% CIA marks on pro-rata basis.

Example: A candidate appearing at the B.A. 4th Semester Examination, 2020, having back in any course in the B.A. 2nd Semester Examination, then the above-mentioned CIA calculation will be valid.

2. Full marks of Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) for the courses like CC, AECC, SEC, CEC, OEC (if any), DSE etc. will be **25** and for **GE** course it will be **50** under the Faculties of Arts and Fine Arts of the University.

Full marks of Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) for **all the courses will be 25** under the Faculty of **Visual Arts** of the University.

3. **All such examinees under the Faculties of Arts, Fine Arts and Visual Arts of the University would not required to undergo any online Examination Form fill up.**
4. **Examination Fees and Admission Fees (if any) will be collected during distribution of Grade Card.**
5. As per latest guidelines published by UGC on July 06, 2020, the period of lockdown shall be treated as 'deemed to be attended' by all the students.
6. If a candidate appeared in the process of Continuous Internal Assessment in a course of the academic programme but failed in that course, then his/her Continuous Internal Assessment marks will be carried forward and whenever he/she appears in that course in near future, this 50% CIA marks will be converted into 20% CIA marks on pro-rata basis.
7. If a candidate is unable to get his/her Continuous Internal Assessment done in each course in due time, then his/her candidature will be cancelled.
