This is for information of all concerned that the final Semesters of UG and PG academic programmes of all departments under the Faculties of Arts, Fine Arts and Visual Arts of the University will be conducted between 1st October, 2020 and 18th October, 2020 in the blended mode (offline and online) as per resolutions adopted by the Executive Council in its emergency meetings held on 15/9/2020 and 21.09.2020 on the basis of the UGC Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar in view of COVID-19 Pandemic, [vide D.O. NO. F1-1/2020 (Secy), dated 29th April, 2020] and UGC Revised Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar for the Universities in view of COVID-19 Pandemic [vide D.O. NO. F1-1/2020 (Secy), dated 6th July, 2020], the verdict of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated August 28, 2020 and approval of UGC regarding conduction of final semester examinations to be completed by 18.10.2020 [vide D.O. NO. 1-10/2020 (CPP - II) dated 16th September, 2020] issued in this matter. University shall strictly abide by the Guidelines issued by the University Grants Commission (UGC) regarding modalities of examinations for final Semesters of UG and PG academic programmes and spirit in the best interest of students maintaining the sanctity of examination.

Detailed modalities of examinations for final Semesters of UG and PG academic programmes are mentioned below:

1. All candidates of the final Semesters of UG and PG academic programmes of all departments under the Faculties of Arts, Fine Arts and Visual Arts of the University will be required to undergo the online Examination Form fill up process. In online Examination Form fill up process, student should mention his/her University Registration Number, SUIN, Exam Roll No, specialization i.e. CEC, OEC (if any), current Email ID and mobile phone number etc. Detailed schedule of such process will be announced in due course of time through University website. After completion of Examination Form fill up process, student should download the Admit Card from University website before appearing in the Examination.

Examination Fees and Admission Fees (if any) will be collected during distribution of Grade Card. Candidates ('Persons with Benchmark Disabilities'), who want to write Examination with Scribe may apply (as per Format attached) to the Joint Registrar (Exam.) using University designated portal at the time of online Examination Form fill up process with all necessary documents of the candidate and the Scribe.

The Portfolio should contain works from previous and final semesters in a ratio to be stipulated by the respective Departments.

- 6. Allotment of Project / Dissertation etc. to be done by the Department either through University website or directly and it will have to be submitted by the students by 01.10.2020 through University web portal in which they have enrolled themselves for examination.
- 7. In case a student of final semester is unable to appear in the examination conducted by the University for whatsoever the reason(s) may be, he/she will be given opportunity to appear in special examinations for such course(s), which shall be conducted by the university as and when feasible. This provision shall be applicable only for the current academic session 2019-20 as a one-time measure.
- 8. It is also to be noted that the students of final semester having backlog examinations to be cleared, would be evaluated by conducting examinations in offline (pen & paper)/ online/ blended (online + offline) mode as per feasibility and suitability of the University.
