The Convener extended a warm welcome to all the members of this Sub-Committee and also appreciated their commitment to the preparation of NAAC accreditation process.

At the outset, the Convenor highlighted the editable errors displayed in the NAAC portal for Rabindra Bharati University's Annual Quality Assurance Reports (AAQR) for the academic years 2018–19, 2019–20, and 2020–21. Subsequently, he presented the latest data template for metrics as published on 9th August 2023. The members examined the revised metrics thoroughly and engaged in detailed discussions regarding its implications.

Based on above study and discussed elaborately following resolutions have been taken

- 1. It was decided that the already submitted AQAR data 0f 2020-2021, which is still editable, shall be reviewed and edited soon.
- 2. It was resolved that the necessary information regarding IQAC shall be uploaded on the University website.
- 3. It was decided that the collection and structuring of data, 2020 onwards, as per the latest metrics proposed by the UGC, for the purpose of NAAC preparation, shall be initiated at the earliest.
- 4. It was further resolved that a meeting of the NAAC Steering Committee with all the Deans, HoDs and TiCs of all three Faculties shall be held next week to elaborate upon the latest metrics proposed by the UGC and also to define the specific assignments of both teachers and officers, with regard to the NAAC preparation works.
- 5. It was decided that filled-in feedback forms shall be collected from students by the HoDs/ TiCs at the earliest. The same can be collected during the forthcoming PG exams, if possible.
