Submission of a paper implies that it is an original unpublished work and is not being submitted for publication elsewhere or has been published elsewhere.

## **Submission Guidelines**

*Format and Font:* Authors should prepare their manuscript using Microsoft Word, Times New Roman 12 font, double spaced with adequate margins in the left-hand side.

**Authorship:** On a separate title page at the beginning, author(s) should mention their name(s), affiliation, designation, e-mail, and contact number.

**Declaration:** Author(s) must declare that the paper has not been published/considered for publication elsewhere.

Abstract: Not more than 200 words with maximum 5 keywords at the beginning of the paper.

*Writing paper in English:* British English or English UK is to be followed, particularly in case of spellings. *Style of Reference:* The APA 6<sup>th</sup> referencing with parenthetical style. For example:
