About the Workshop

According to All-India Survey of Higher Education (AISHE), 2021-22, A total of 1,168 Universities/University level Institutions, 45,473 Colleges and 12,002 Stand Alone Institutions were registered under AISHE. Total enrolment in higher education has increased to nearly 4.33 crore. Total Ph.D. enrolment has increased to 2.13 lakh. The total number of faculty/teachers in 2021-22 is 15.98 lakh. According to TOI report published online in March 23, 2023 India is 4th highest producer of research output (1.3 million during 2017-2022) just behind China, USA and UK. But according to impact India's position is 9th in the Global Academic arena. Why? Increasing numbers of researchers and their outcomes have faced the tremendous competition for the preparation of research report and the publication of research outputs. Such competition for many researchers compelled to find some 'short-cuts' and resort to behaviour and acts that are considered unethical. Sometimes the rules and regulations formulated for the research also stimulates to do so instead of doing better and qualitative research. Fabrication, falsification, and plagiarism (usually referred to as FFP) are three ethical issues characterized as research misconduct. Several measures have been recommended by the UGC to overcome this issue.

3-days workshop on Academic Integrity and Research Publishing organized by the Research Development Cell of Rabindra Bharati University is an attempt to describe the ethical research practices and the issues raised above from the foundation of credible and impactful scholarship. This three-day workshop aims to foster a culture of honesty, rigor and excellence among researchers while providing practical guidance on successful research publishing. The workshop will feature interactive sessions, expert lectures, and hands-on activities.
