NOTICE

Pursuant to the G.O. No.-753/XXII-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 31.01.2022 issued by the Chief Secretary, Government of West Bengal and Memo No.:89-Edn(CS)/10M-32/2021 dated 31.01.2022 issued by the Principal Secretary, Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal, the undersigned has been directed by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor to notify all concerned (Teachers, Officers, Other Supporting Staff and Students) of Rabindra Bharati University, Rabindra Bharati Museum, West Bengal State Akademi of Dance, Drama, Music and Visual Arts and Centre for Online and Distance Education, Rabindra Bharati University that the offline classes at UG/PG and higher level, including Ph.D and Research works in the University will re-open on and from 3rd February, 2022.

The Heads of all Departments under three Faculties are requested to decide, in consultation with the respective Departmental Committee and the Dean of the respective Faculty, about the exact modalities of conducting classes on and from 3rd February, 2022 in strict adherence to the Covid norms, as mentioned in the enclosures to the Order No. 1058-Edn (CS) dated 28.10.2021 issued by the Principal Secretary, Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal.

All administrative offices and sections, including those in academic Departments, Centres, Rabindra Bharati Museum, West Bengal State Akademi of Dance, Drama, Music and Visual Arts and the Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE) of the University will remain open with 75% attendance.

Only 75% visitors with a maximum of 150 visitors at a time shall be allowed to visit Rabindra Bharati Museum. The Light and Sound Shows at Jorasanko shall also be operated with 75% seating capacity of the premises with a maximum of 100 spectators at a time.

Wearing of masks, maintenance of physical distancing and health and hygiene protocol must be followed at all times. Those having symptoms of fever, cough or difficulty in breathing should not enter the campus.
